This project consists of constructing a new 7,880 GSF addition to the Deer's Head Hospital Center to house a kidney dialysis unit and renovating 7,650 GSF of the hospital building for administrative and support functions.

### **GO Bond Recommended Actions**

#### **1. Approve**

DHMH concurs with the recommendation to approve. These funds are essential to improve the capabilities of the kidney dialysis unit at Deer's Head Hospital Center. The current kidney dialysis unit: fails to meet basic space requirements, has insufficient space to maintain current service levels, is in violation of HIPPA and COMAR privacy requirements, and is not ADA Compliant.
