**Governor Martin O'Malley and the exclusive bargaining representatives have reached an agreement adding two new premium holidays in 2014. This means that the State will pay your portion of your medical, prescription, and dental premiums for pay periods occurring in April of 2014.**

## HOW WILL THIS AFFECT YOU?



### **ACTIVE EMPLOYEES** (Regular and University):

- Biweekly & Monthly – No deductions for Medical, Drug and/or Dental insurance premiums for April 2014.
- All Active Employees - Regular deductions for Life and AD&D insurance, Long Term Care and Flexible Spending Accounts will still be taken.



### **LAW-ON-THE-JOB-INJURY, LAW-PERSONAL, CONTRACTUAL, ORP, PART-TIME:**

- No deductions for Medical, Rx and/or Dental insurance premiums for April 2014.
- Updated payment coupons for the remainder of 2014 will be mailed at the end of April 2014.



### **RETIREES:**

- No deductions for Medical, Drug and/or Dental insurance premiums for April 2014.
- Regular deductions for Life insurance premiums will still be taken.



### **SPECIAL RETIREES:**

- No deductions for Medical, Rx and/or Dental insurance premiums for April 2014.
- If enrolled, your life insurance premium will be deducted from your pension check instead of paying for it by coupon during these two months.
- Updated payment coupons for the remainder of 2014 will be mailed at the end of April 2014.
