SUMMARY

The Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE), supports the development and operation of educational and library programs throughout the State. MSDE also oversees locally-owned State and regional library resource centers in Baltimore City and in St. Mary's, Washington, and Wicomico Counties.

Beginning in FY 2008, the Division of Library Development and Services of the Maryland State Department of Education will manage a capital grant program for public libraries throughout Maryland. There are 24 public library systems in Maryland with a total of 174 branches, and many of these branches are in need of replacement, renovation, and upgrades to provide wiring for technology.

Public Library Capital Grant Program: This program was added to the Capital Improvement Program due to the passage of Chapter 494 of the Acts of 2006, which stated that beginning in FY 2008 and each year thereafter, the Governor shall include \$5,000,000 in the annual budget for county library capital projects.
