**MAY 5, 2010**

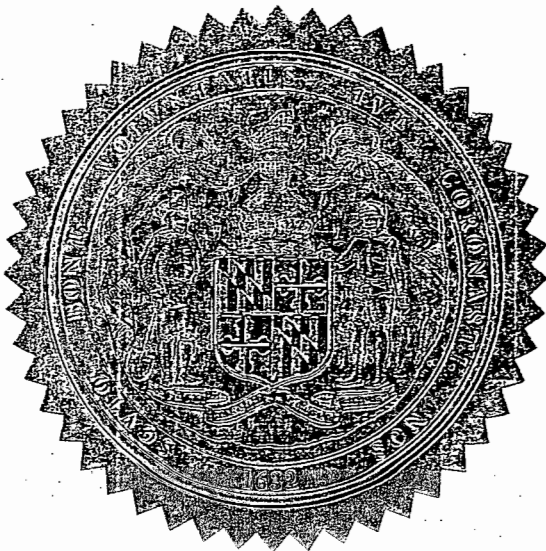
**WHEREAS,** *Maryland state employees contribute significantly to the well-being and quality of life of all citizens of our state; and*
