

**FIRST MODIFICATION TO
PHARMACY BENEFITS PURCHASING POOL MANAGEMENT
AND PHARMACY BENEFITS PLAN ADMINISTRATION
SERVICES CONTRACT**

THIS MODIFICATION AGREEMENT is made effective the 1st day of July, 2008 by and between Catalyst Rx, Inc. and the State of Maryland, acting through the Department of Budget and Management.

IN CONSIDERATION of the promises and the covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. Definitions

In this Modification, the following words have the meanings indicated:

1.1 "Contract" means the Contract for Pharmacy Benefits Purchasing Pool Management and Pharmacy Benefits Plan Administration Services, dated April 7, 2007, between the Contractor and the State of Maryland acting through the Department of Budget and Management.

1.2 "Contractor" means Catalyst Rx, Inc., a Nevada corporation with a principal business address of 800 King Farm Boulevard, Rockville, MD 20850.

1.3 "Modification" means this Modification Agreement.

1.4 "RFP" means the Request for Proposals for Pharmacy Benefits Purchasing Pool Management and Pharmacy Benefits Plan Administration Services, No. F10R6200071, dated October 4, 2005, incorporated into the Contract at Article 2.

2. Scope of Modification

This Modification amends the Contract specifically as described herein. Except as specifically revised by the terms of this Modification, all of the terms of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect and shall apply to this Modification.

3. Providing Access to Negotiated Discounts

For drugs and items which are not covered by the State's prescription benefits plan, the Contractor shall make available to members in the State's prescription benefits plan the discounted price that the Contractor has negotiated with the dispensing pharmacy. This service and these prices shall be made available at no cost to the State.
