The State of Maryland conducted a Pre-Proposal Conference at the State Office building located at 45 Calvert Street in Annapolis, MD, on July 10, 2008. An attendance list with the names of those attendees signing in is located at Attachment 2.

The Procurement Officer, Joy Epstein, reviewed the RFP:

Section 1-reviewed points related to type, terms and conditions of the solicitation,
Section 3-reviewed proposal format guidance and requirements, and
Section 4-explained the evaluation criteria and selection process and how the State will select the most advantageous proposal.

The following Attachments were reviewed:

Attachment A- pointed out that the contract has mandatory terms and any exceptions need to be stated in the offerors' transmittal letter.

Attachment B-emphasized all blanks are to be filled in and that "domestic corporation" means a corporation registered in Maryland and that a "foreign corporation" means a corporation not registered in Maryland,

Attachment F-explained Price Proposal Instructions and Form

Attachment G-explained Living Wage Requirements and filling out the Living Wage Affidavit.

The State's MBE liaison, Tom McLamore, summarized the RFP, Section 1.10, "Minority Business Enterprise", to encourage MBE participation in the absence of an MBE goal.

The State's Fleet Manager, Larry Williams, summarized the RFP, Section 2, Scope of Work, describing the evolution of the WebFleet software and the current environment in which the software is being used today. The DOIT department representatives Terraceta Tubaya and Lan Pasek were available for support regarding any technical questions. Ms. Tubaya mentioned that the website links needed updated in the RFP sections 1.30, Non-Visual Access, and 2.3.4, Operating Environment. Amendment #1 provides the corrected website link.
