## Competitive Grants Summary

To support the General Assembly’s goal to promote the pursuit of funding opportunities that align with State priorities, the Department of Budget and Management has prepared a comprehensive report that summarizes all competitive grant opportunities pursued by the State from the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) and Inflation Reduction Act (IRA). Per the General Assembly’s request, the State will provide quarterly updates on this information. This is the first of what will become a quarterly report effort to establish a process for legislative review and tracking of competitive grant opportunities prior to the commitment of State funds.

The report contains a list of agencies that pursued competitive funds from IIJA and IRA along with the status of the application, and any State match that is required. Information is presented in two ways: by the State Agency, to provide insight into how each agency has pursued funding and by Funding Source.
