Purpose: Recovery Now Funding

The Rental Services program, Department of Housing and Community Development, shall provide grants to pay for up to 30 days of emergency housing.

June 2 - Program Highlights and Plans to Allocate Remaining Balance:

- All but Baltimore City and Frederick CoCs have returned grant agreements and are in internal routing. Both have committed to returning agreement by June 4.
- Once an agreement is fully executed, funding will be disbursed.
- All internal divisions related to the routing and funding processes are standing by to ensure disbursement of all funds by 6/30/21
