Purpose: Recovery Now Funding

The Commission shall provide grants to community providers of services under Title 7 of the Health – General Article, concerning services provided to individuals served by the Developmental Disabilities Administration (DDA), to support pandemic-related reopening, transformation, and revenue loss.

June 2 - Program Highlights and Plans to Allocate Remaining Balance:

• The MCHRC issued a non-competitive RFP on Thursday, April 15, 2021 in accordance with timelines provided by DBM guidance and feedback. A public call with potential applicants was held on Wednesday, April 21, 2021. Applications were streamlined and were due to MCHRC by 12:00 noon, Monday, May 10, 2021. The MCHRC received 116 applications requesting a total of \$3.4M. The MCHRC is contemplating ways to reach out to eligible applicants who did not apply by the May 10 deadline. Grant awards will be made at the Commission's meeting on June 4, 2021. MCHRC will encumber funds by mid-June 2021 and process fund distributions in accordance with the timeline discussed with DBM leadership.
