The Maryland Insurance Administration is an independent unit of State government organized in accordance with Title 2, Subtitle 1 of the Insurance Article. The agency promulgates regulations to carry out the Insurance Article and issues bulletins and other guidance for the insurance industry and consumers of insurance products in the State. The MIA does not receive any money from the State's General Fund. The Administration is a specially funded state agency supported entirely through fees and assessments on the insurance industry.
