## Frederick Sports Mural Fact Sheet

**Project owner:** Community Arts, Inc, a 501c3 nonprofit, has an MOU with the City of Frederick to build on city property. Community Arts Inc will be solely responsible for perpetual maintenance.

**Project:** The Frederick Sports Mural

**Artist:** Yemi Fagbohun will take 18 months to paint the mural. His 40-year career includes many murals and other forms of art commissioned locally and across the globe.

**The request:** \$50,000 in state funding for the pre- construction/ Phase 1 of the \$2 million public art mural located on the site of Harry Grove Stadium in the City of Frederick.

**Size:** It will be 550 feet long and 14 feet high and 7,700 square feet built outside the stadium and run adjacent to the outfield wall.

**Details:** The mural celebrates athletics in Frederick County over 125 years with 250 honorees in 30 sports including Olympians, professional players, collegiate athletes, outstanding coaches and one horse, a Preakness winner.

**Amenities:** Lighting, boardwalk spanning the mural, benches, landscaping, interpretive signage, handicap parking. [www.fredericksportsmural.org](http://www.fredericksportsmural.org), a book and social media pages will provide additional information.

**Tourism Impact:** The CoStar report estimates there will be 44 million views per year of the mural from MD355 and Interstate 70. Upon completion, Community Arts, Inc will apply for Guinness certification as the world's largest sports mural by one artist, to increase tourism and economic impact.

**Economic Impact:** Community Arts, Inc has engaged Frederick County contractors to complete this project. All nonprofit board, staff and volunteers are Frederick County residents. Private/public partnerships, grants, corporate and individual donations will fund this public art project.
