## General Response of the Office of People's Counsel (OPC)

The Department of Legislative Services concurs with the Governor's allowance. OPC appreciates the careful review by Samuel Quist, DLS budget analyst, and agrees with the DLS recommendation.

# **Additional Comments**

The DLS analysis notes that Chapter 607 of 2021 expanded OPC's statutory responsibilities. OPC received a budget amendment for fiscal year 2022 to reflect its new statutory responsibilities and its overall increasing workload. We scaled our 2022 request to reflect the effective date of October 1, 2021, three months into the fiscal year.

The additional funds for fiscal year 2022 have enabled OPC to increase the scope of its work consistent with its new statutory considerations, to hire three contractual attorneys, and to retain additional technical litigation support.
