# Amendment #3 to Request for Proposals (RFP) Pharmacy Benefits Plan Management Services and Pharmacy Purchasing Pool Management Solicitation No. F10B0400006 January 27, 2010

This Amendment is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above named RFP. All information contained herein is binding on all Offerors who respond to this RFP. Specific parts of the RFP have been amended. The following changes/additions are listed below; new language has been double underlined and marked in bold (ex. <u>new language</u>) and language deleted has been marked with a strikeout (ex. <u>language deleted</u>).

Revised versions of "Attachment J - Technical Proposal" and "Attachment K – Financial Proposal" are provided with this Amendment, and incorporate all changes from Amendment #1 through Amendment #3.

6. Amend Attachment K-1, Instruction C. as follows:

C.	5.	Along with "pass-through" pricing, the guarantees quoted in your financial proposal (Attachment K-4, lines 6 through 44 17) shall apply to each Purchasing Pool Participant on an annual basis for the duration of a Purchasing Pool Participant's participation in the Maryland Rx Program. The State, as a Purchasing Pool Participant, shall enjoy the benefit of these guarantees with respect to the State's Plan.
	9.	The guaranteed AWP discount shall be applicable to only the drug-type and place of service quoted. Specialty drug guarantees shall apply only to Specialty drug claims processed at identified Specialty pharmacies in the network. Prescriptions for specialty drugs sent to the mail order pharmacy shall be rerouted to a Specialty pharmacy to be filled by the specialty pharmacy and subject to the pricing guarantees provided for specialty drugs (see Attachment K-4, lines 9, 13 and 17). Since each pricing guarantee is independent of the other pricing guarantees, any surplus in one pricing component cannot be applied to a deficit in another pricing category.

  - (ii) Renumbering of each line item from #8 onward on Att. K-4 and K-5.
  - (iii) Revising the required proposal format to require pricing guarantees (drug ingredient cost, dispensing fees, and rebates) for specialty drugs filled at retail pharmacies and specialty drugs filled at specialty pharmacies.
