

**FIRST MODIFICATION TO
PHARMACY BENEFITS PURCHASING POOL MANAGEMENT
AND PHARMACY BENEFITS PLAN ADMINISTRATION
SERVICES CONTRACT**

THIS MODIFICATION AGREEMENT (the "Modification Agreement") is made this 4 day of May, 2012 by and between Express Scripts, Inc. (the "Contractor") and the State of Maryland, acting through the Department of Budget and Management (the "Department").

IN CONSIDERATION of the promises and the covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

1. Definitions

In this Modification, the following words have the meaning indicated:

1.1 "Contract" means the Contract for Pharmacy Benefits Purchasing Pool Management and Pharmacy Benefits Plan Administration Services, dated February 12, 2012, between the Contractor and the Department.

1.2 "RFP" means the Request for Proposals for Pharmacy Benefits Purchasing Pool Management and Pharmacy Benefits Plan Administration Services, No. F10B0400006, dated December 8, 2009, including addenda, attachments and Excel worksheets, as amended through August 16, 2010.

2. RFP Attachment J-4.

RFP Attachment J-4 (Administrative Requirements), Section AR-26(b) (Communication Requirements) is hereby amended as follows:

b.) The Contractor will produce ID cards which are compliant with current NCPDP standards, and include the following information:

- i.) the name of the entity administering the pharmacy benefits;
- ii.) the group number applicable to the employee/retiree;
- iii.) an identification number for the employee/retiree, which is not to be the Employee/retiree's SSN; and
- iv.) the bank identification number necessary for electronic billing.

3. Scope of Modification.

This Modification Agreement amends the Contract specifically as described herein. Except as specifically revised by the terms of this Modification Agreement, all of the terms of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect and shall apply to this Modification Agreement.
