Requesting Agency Remarks: The Department of General Services, Office of State Procurement (DGS-OSP) is conducting the new procurement on behalf of the Department, as it has limited staff resources with the experience and expertise to manage the high number of healthcare solicitations simultaneously.

The purpose of this contract is to continue health benefits for the State Law Enforcement Officers Labor Alliance (SLEOLA) eligible participants within the State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program. The State offers a full complement of benefits to attract and retain valued employees as well as ensure their long-term health and well-being.

Due to the annual Open Enrollment period held prior to the beginning of each calendar year it is ideal for all employee benefit contracts to be awarded no later than nine months prior to the effective date of the contract.
