FIRST MODIFICATION TO CONSULTING AND ACTUARIAL SERVICES FOR THE STATE EMPLOYEE AND RETIREE HEALTH AND WELFARE BENEFITS PROGRAM CONTRACT

THIS FIRST MODIFICATION is made effective this $\underline{\mathcal{T}}_{\mathcal{H}}^{\mathcal{H}}$ day of <u>Deteber</u>, 2013 by and between The Segal Company (Eastern States), Inc. (the "Contractor") and the State of Maryland, acting through the Department of Budget and Management (the "Department").

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2012, the Department entered into a contract with Contractor to provide Consulting and Actuarial Services for the State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program (the "Services") pursuant to Request for Proposals for Consulting and Actuarial Services for the State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program, Project No. F10B140001 issued on April 14, 2011, and all amendments thereto issued in writing by the State (the "RFP"); and

WHEREAS, the Contractor desires to add an additional MBE subcontractor to assist the existing MBE subcontractor and the Department and Contractor desire to modify the Contract to clarify the task order process so that Contractor can successfully continue to perform the Services.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the Recitals which are hereby made a substantive part hereof, and the promises and the covenants herein contained, the parties agree to modify the Contract as follows:

1. The sentence following RFP $\S3.2.1.1$ and immediately preceding $\S3.2.1.1(A)$ is deleted and replaced with the following:

Services shall be provided via a task order process using the pre-approved fully-loaded labor rates applicable to their labor categories as follows:

Services shall be provided via a task order process as follows:

The task ordes process for task orders other than task orders for survey services as described in RFP §3.2.7 and communication services as described in RFP 3.2.6 shall be submitted to the Department pursuant to the task order process below using the pre-approved fully-loaded labor rates applicable to the respective labor categories set forth in Contractor's price proposal (Attachment F).

The task order process for task orders for survey services as described in RFP §3.2.7 and communication services as described in RFP 3.2.6 shall be submitted to the Department pursuant to the task order process below; provided however, that instead of a detailed cost estimate pursuant to RFP §3.2.1.1(B)(8), Contractor shall provide the Department with a detailed cost estimate with hourly rates using the pre-approved fully-loaded labor rates applicable to the respective labor categories set forth in Contractor's price proposal (Attachment F) for work performed by Contractor staff and a pass-through of the invoice for survey services and communication services performed by Contractor.

2. MBE Participation Plan. In fulfilling its commitment to meet an MBE goal of 27% for the Consulting portion of the Contract agreed to by Contractor and incorporated into the Contract, the Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) participation plan submitted by the Contractor on Form D-1 dated May 20, 2011, (the "Original Plan") is replaced with the revised participation plan identified on revised Forms D-1 and D-3, for both Managed Care Advisors and EurekaFacts, LLC attached hereto and

incorporated by reference herein (collectively, the "Revised Plan"). Contractor's MBE commitment to Managed Care Advisors shall be reduced from 27% from 20%, and Contractor's MBE commitment to EurekaFacts, LLC shall be 7% with a total MBE goal maintained at 27% for the Consulting portion of the Contract.

3. Scope of Modification. This First Modification amends the Contract specifically as described herein. Except as specifically revised by the terms of this Modification, all of the terms of the Contract, including but not limited to the not-to-exceed provisions of Contract §4, shall remain in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed.
