34. **Question:** Section 4.1.2 of the IFB states that we must agree to comply with every section, subsection and addendum of this solicitation. Will one statement be sufficient or must it be in detail?

However, please be advised that a bid which takes exceptions to the terms of the IFB, any amendments thereto or the State's Contract will be rejected.

Bidders are required to submit acknowledgement of the receipt of all addenda to the IFB on company letterhead. The acknowledgement should be signed by an individual who is authorized to commit the Bidder to the services and requirements as stated in this IFB. See Amendment #2, item #1.
