Requesting Agency Remarks: The 2021 Maryland Police Reform mandated the Bi-Annual Mental Health Check-in Program, Maryland Public Safety Code Ann. §3-209 (e), which went into effect on July 1, 2022. The contractor will provide the mental-health check-in service to a total of 3,000 active police officers from the following Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs): Maryland State Police (MSP), Maryland Transit Administration (MTA), Maryland Transportation Authority (MDTA), Motor Vehicle Administration (MVA), Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Department of General Services (DGS), Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services (DPSCS), Comptroller, and Maryland Alcohol and Tobacco Commission.

The contractor is working to implement changes to increase the subcontractor usage and meet the MBE goal.
