Brownfield Cleanup Grants Review of Fiscal Year 2025 Funded Projects

Objective

This document provides a high-level review of the Environmental Protection Agency's <u>Brownfield Cleanup Grants</u> Fiscal Year 2025 Funded Projects. This program funds projects that carry out cleanup activities at brownfield sites to address hazardous substances and contaminants in the area.

Program Summary

A brownfield site is a property where the expansion, redevelopment, or reuse of which may be complicated by the presence or potential presence of a hazardous substance, pollutant, contaminant, controlled substance, petroleum, or petroleum product, or is mine-scarred land. The Cleanup Grant Program funds cleanup activities and direct costs associated with management of the grant.

Application Deadline	Applications must be submitted by January 28, 2026, by 11:59 PM ET . Grant applications are submitted through <u>Grants.gov.</u> Entities that are applying for an FY26 Cleanup Grant may not apply for an FY26 Multipurpose Grant.		
Funding Overview	For FY 2026: ""> Total Funding: \$107,000,000 "It is anticipated that up to ten awards for up to \$500,000 and 26 awards for between \$500,001 and \$4,000,000 will be made under this award.		
Eligible Uses	 Direct costs associated with programmatic management of the grant, such as required performance reporting, cleanup oversight, and environmental monitoring of cleanup work. Direct costs associated with the cleanup of a brownfield site. Local governments may use up to 10% of their grant funds for monitoring the health of populations exposed to hazardous substances, or the monitoring and enforcement of institutional control used to prevent human exposure to hazardous substances from a site. 		
Cost Sharing Requirements	» No cost share is required, and voluntary cost share will not be accepted under this competition.

FY25 National-Level Summary

For the FY25 Brownfields Cleanup Grant funding cycle, the EPA announced that 207 communities were selected to receive 214 grant awards for a total of over \$224 million in funding for Brownfields Assessment, Revolving Loan Fund, and Cleanup (ARC) Grant programs. No funding was awarded to Maryland communities under this round of funding.
