The Small, Minority, and Women-Owned Businesses Account (SMWOBA) program receives 1.5% from the proceeds of video lottery terminals (VLT) at each of the State's video lottery facilities. Eligible fund managers receive grants to provide loans and investment capital to small, minority, or women-owned businesses in the State. SMWOBA also receives funding from the Strategic Energy Investment Fund (SEIF) in increasing increments through fiscal year 2028 to fund access to capital for small, minority, womenowned, or veteran-owned businesses in the clean energy industry in the State. SMWOBA also receives funding from sports betting application fees and license renewal fees, which go to the Small, Minority-Owned, and Women-Owned Business Sports Wagering Assistance Fund (SMOWOBSWAF).
