

FIRST MODIFICATION TO THIRD PARTY ADMINISTRATIVE (TPA)
SERVICES FOR FLEXIBLE SPENDING ACCOUNTS
(FSAs) – HEALTHCARE AND DEPENDENT CARE

THIS FIRST MODIFICATION is made this 5th of May 2012 by and between ConnectYourCare, LLC (Contractor), Express Scripts, Inc. (Guarantor), and the State of Maryland, acting through the Department of Budget and Management.

WHEREAS, the Contractor, Guarantor, and the State of Maryland acting through the Department of Budget and Management executed a contract dated 21st of January, 2010 for Third Party Administrative (TPA) Services for Flexible Spending Accounts (FSAs) – Healthcare And Dependent Care (the "Contract") relating to Request for Proposals Project No. F10B9200027 issued June 30, 2009 as amended (the "RFP").

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the promises and the covenants herein contained, the parties agree to modify the Contract as follows:

1. In accordance with the federally-mandated cap on FSA contributions under the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act of 2010 (PPACA), RFP Attachment G-4, Current FSA Plan Design for the Healthcare FSA, is hereby amended as follows:

Effective July 1, 2012, the maximum annual limit on a healthcare flexible spending account shall be \$2,500.

2. This Modification and the State Employee and Retiree Health and Welfare Benefits Program Flexible Spending Account Plan benefit options shall comply with PPACA, §125(i) of the Internal Revenue Code, and the applicable regulations promulgated thereunder.

3. This Modification amends the Contract specifically as described herein. Except as specifically revised by the terms of this Modification, all of the terms of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect and shall apply to this Modification.
