Amendment #4 to Request for Proposals (RFP) State Medical Director and Occupational Medical Services for Maryland State Agencies Solicitation No. 050B6400002 May 6th, 2016

This Amendment is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above named RFP. All information contained herein is binding on all Offerors who respond to this RFP. Specific parts of the RFP have been amended. The following changes/additions are listed below; new language has been double underlined and marked in bold (ex. <u>new language</u>) and language deleted has been marked with a strikeout (ex. <u>language deleted</u>).

Amend Section 3.2.22 as follows:

3.2.22 Optional 24/7 Service Facility within the Confines of Baltimore City

- 3.2.22.1 As an optional function, the State requires a 24/7 location to perform services listed in Sections 3.2.16, 3.2.17 and 3.2.20 above within the area of Baltimore City identified in 3.2.22.2. During Normal State Business hours the Contractor would conduct all services listed above at the specified location. within Baltimore City After normal business hours (5:01pm 7:59am) and on weekends and holidays, the Contractor shall conduct at least US DOT drug and alcohol testing at the specified location. within Baltimore City
- 3.2.22.2 The proposed location must be within the confines of Baltimore City, specifically, North of Hanover Street, South of Northern Parkway, West of I-95 & I-895, and East of the intersection of Northern Parkway and Liberty Heights Avenue.

 The proposed location must be within a 6 mile radius of the intersection of E Pratt Street and Light Street.
- 3.2.22.3 The Contractor will be paid a fixed monthly fee to operate the 24/7 operation location. Fixed fees will be paid for any services rendered at the location based on prices quoted in the Financial Proposal.
