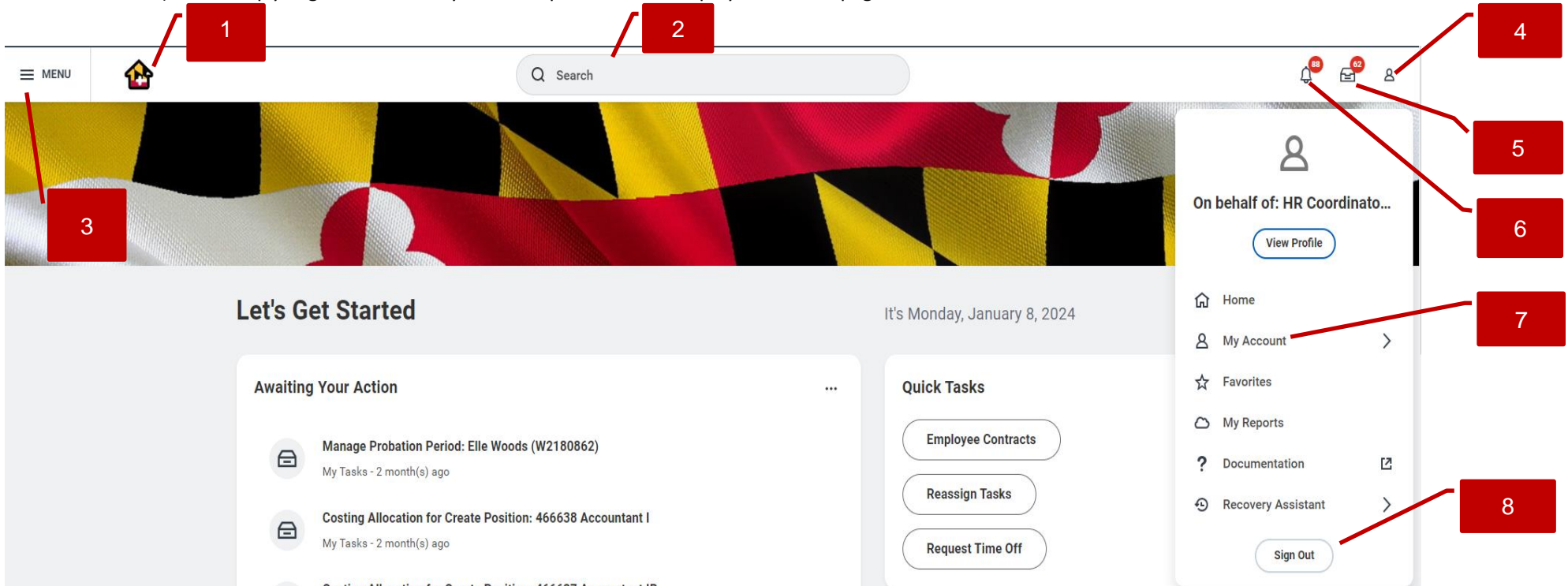


SPS LANDING PAGE





Commonly used pages in SPS, called landing pages, are used to view data and perform tasks. Each page will have navigational tools (menus, icons, buttons, fields, etc.) which help you get around the system. The picture below displays the Home page.



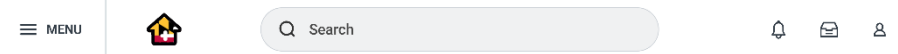
1	SPS Icons: Return to Home Page
2	Search: Predictive suggestions return common matching results to which you have access.
3	Menu: Applications found on landing pages that provide quick access to tasks and information used on a regular basis (e.g., personal information, your account, Benefits, etc.) Some applications are configurable
4	Profile Icon: Opens SPS Menu options (based on your security access). Provides access to your landing pages, account settings, favorites, reports, and access to sign out of SPS.
5	My Tasks box: Central location for finding tasks that require your attention.
6	Notifications: Informs you of relevant events that have been completed.
7	My Account: Change/manage your password and password questions and manage your preferences.
8	Sign Out (button): Click to sign out of SPS.

COMMON APPLICATIONS

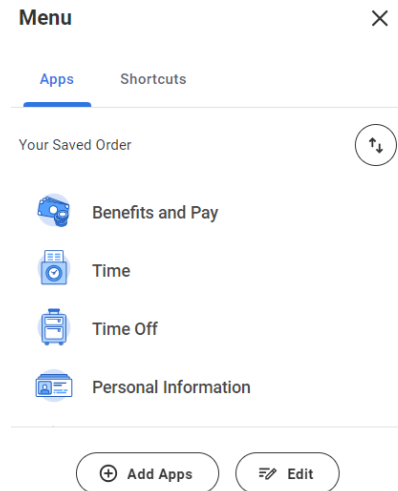
Some applications are permanent and cannot be deleted from a landing page. Others can be added and configured as desired. **NOTE:** Applications display based on your system access. Some common applications are listed below:

Application	Action and Activities
 Benefits and Pay	View benefits and pay related information and Initiate life event changes.
 New Announcements	View SPS specific system announcements.
 Personal Information	Manage and view your personal contact information, emergency contacts, and name.
 My Account	Manage your passwords and account settings.




CONFIGURING APPLICATIONS



1. In the top right corner of the landing page, click on the **MENU** icon.



2. Add, remove, or reorder applications. Do one or more of the following to configure the applications on the Menu.

Add an application	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the Add Apps icon. • Click the Plus  icon and select from the list of existing apps.
Remove an application	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the Edit icon. • Click the Minus  icon next to the app to remove it from displaying in your menu.
Reorder Applications 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use your mouse to grab the app from the six dots and drag to the desired row.

3. When you are done, click **Save**.
